The Bibo weekend brunch has also proved popular, with steaks being prepared over an oak wood grill.

The Grill serves classic dishes in a traditional way, and has been doing so since Audrey Hepburn, Sean Connery and a variety of Princes, Dukes and Counts made the Marbella Club their base in the 50s and 60s. During the summer nights The Grill is easily one of the most romantic venues in Marbella.
